PUBLIC OPEN HOUSE

ON RICHFIELD ARTERIALS COMPLETE STREETS STUDY

JANUARY 21, 2009

The Richfield Transportation Commission, a citizens' advisory group to the Richfield City Council, is leading a study of four arterial streets in Richfield. They are: Penn Avenue; Lyndale Avenue; Nicollet Avenue; and, Portland Avenue. As these arterial streets age and need to be rebuilt, the Transportation Commission is interested in considering possible changes in their design that will better serve the community in the future. The Commission wants to hear from you on how well Richfield's arterial streets perform in serving all users, i.e. cars, transit, bicyclists and pedestrians.

During January and February 2009, the study will evaluate the existing conditions and identify deficiencies in the roadways. From March through May 2009, the study will focus on developing recommendations to address the corridor deficiencies. Final recommendations are anticipated to the City Council in June 2009.

Public Input

Study progress will be updated at the Transportation Commission monthly meetings on the 1st Wednesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. at Richfield City Hall. The Commission meetings are open to the public. Public open house meetings are scheduled for Wednesday, January 21st, Wednesday, March 18th and Wednesday, May 20th 2009.
