Subject: Mill and Overlay Project

Dear Resident or Business Owner:

As part of the City's street maintenance program, the following streets are scheduled for mill and overlay:

Bloomington Avenue from 63rd Street to Diagonal Blvd.
12th Avenue from 66th to 78th Street.
Cedar Avenue from 74th to 77th Street.
63rd Street from Lyndale to Dupont Avenue
Emerson Avenue from 66th Street to Dupont Avenue

The Project is scheduled to begin on Tuesday, September 7th, 2010, at 7:00 AM, depending on weather and other circumstances.

During this time, there will be NO PARKING on street during the day until paving is complete

The paving project should last **about a week once work has begun on your street** depending on weather conditions. Several operations will take place at various times during the project. Some of the construction is fast moving and difficult to schedule an exact time, so your cooperation is needed to ensure the project can be completed. Except for a few brief times during paving, you will have access to your driveway, and at least one lane will be open to traffic.

Mill and overlay involves grinding off the top two to three inches of old blacktop and re-paving the street with new blacktop.

Mill and overlay is one of the projects funded by the franchise fee.
