MINNEAPOLIS-ST. PAUL INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT LONG TERM COMPREHENSIVE PLAN UPDATE

The Metropolitan Airports Commission (MAC) has completed a draft of the updated Long Term Comprehensive Plan (LTCP) for the Minneapolis-St. Paul International Airport. The general public is invited to review this document and provide written comments to the MAC.

The LTCP Update focuses on improvements to passenger facilities to meet the 2030 forecasts. The only proposed modifications to the airfield are taxiway improvements to facilitate future airfield circulation.

The document will be available for viewing on the MAC website starting January 20, 2010 (www.mspairport.com/about-msp/long-term-comp-plan.aspx). Written comments will be accepted until close of business on Friday, February 19, 2010.
